

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The Government of the united Republic of Tanzania and the union of Africa Population Studies are pleased to invite you to be part of the **5th African Population Conference** to be held in **Arusha, Tanzania**, between **December 10-14, 2007**. The African Population Conference is organized every four years in order to review the state of knowledge on various population issues affecting the African continent. The conference brings together a diverse set of professionals, including: multi-disciplinary scholars, government officials, parliamentarians, service providers, multilateral and bilateral donors, the media and civil society. The conference plays a key role in strengthening networks; enhancing the visibility of African population issues, and promoting an integrated approach to the study and application of knowledge on population dynamics in development planning.

The conference will consist of consist of over 50 plenary and parallel sessions, poster presentations and technical workshops in support of the general theme of the meeting which is **“Emerging Issues on Population and Development in Africa”**

Interested scholars and practitioners are invited to submit abstracts to present papers during the formal sessions to address the overall theme of the conference. The deadline for submission of abstracts in **April 30, 2007** and the abstracts **MUST** be submitted through an online submission system kindly made available to the conference through support from the IUSSP and the Princeton University. Decisions on successful abstracts will be communicated by **May 31, 2007** and authors of accepted papers should upload the full papers onto the website by **September 30, 2007**.
